3 County Students Compete At Intel International Science, Engineering Fair

SAN BERNARDINO – Three San Bernardino County high school students competed at the Intel International Science and Engineering Fair, which was held in Los Angeles from May 14-19.

The students represented San Bernardino County from the unified school districts of Redlands and Rialto. Andrea Noronha, a senior at Redlands High School, placed third in the category of chemistry and received an honorable mention from the American Chemical Society.

Rialto High School's Nadley Aisuan, a junior, and Ryan Ramsey, a senior, also took part in the fair. Aisuan competed in the category of cellular and molecular biology. Ramsey was entered in the category for engineering mechanics.

Noronha, Aisuan and Ramsey all competed at the San Bernardino, Inyo and Mono regional Science and Engineering Fair, which is organized by the San Bernardino County Superintendent of Schools' Alliance for Education, in April.

Nearly 1,800 high school students from 78 countries and territories around the world participated in this year's international event. The fair provided an opportunity for the students to showcase independent research and compete for millions of dollars in prizes.

San Bernardino County Superintendent of Schools helped in covering the costs for the students from the county attending the Intel International Fair.
